### **DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE**

The following directions were resourced via Mapquest

**FROM Ithaca via NY 34B:** Left onto Sharpsteen Rd, Right onto County Hwy-153 / Pleasant Valley Rd., Take 1<sup>st</sup> left onto Smith Rd / County Hwy-178. Site is on the Left.

**FROM Syracuse via I-81 S:** I-81 S to EXIT 12 for US-11 / NY-41 / NY-281 toward “Homer/Cortland”. Merge onto Main Street Connector. Left onto SR 281 / NY 281 about 2.2 miles. Right onto SR 222 / NY 222 and follow about 9.2 mi. Left onto Main St / NY38. Take 1<sup>st</sup> Right onto Spring St / County Hwy-100. Stay straight to go onto Spring Street Ext. / County Hwy 190. Take 1<sup>st</sup> Left onto Smith Rd / County Hwy – 178. Site is on the Right.

**FROM Binghamton via I-81 N:** Take Exit 11 for NY-13 toward Cortland. Left onto NY13 / Clinton Ave. Right onto Clinton Ave / NY-13. Stay straight to go onto Groton Ave / NY-222. Follow NY-222 about 10.4 mi. Left onto Main St / NY-38 then 1<sup>st</sup> right onto Spring St / County Hwy-100. Stay straight to go onto Spring Street Ext. / County Hwy 190. Take 1<sup>st</sup> Left onto Smith Rd / County Hwy – 178. Site is on the Right.

**FROM Rochester via I-490 / I-90 E:** after merging on to I-90 E toward Albany, take EXIT 41 for NY-414 toward Waterloo / Clyde. Merge onto Ridge Rd / NY-414 toward Waterloo / Seneca Falls / Montezuma Refuge. Turn Left onto SR 318 / NY-318. Then Left onto US Route 20 / US-20 E / NY-5. Continue on US-20 E / Ny-5 about 11.7 mi. Right onto North Street / NY-34 / NY-38. Continue on NY-34 about 24.8 mi. Turn Left onto N Lansing School Rd. which becomes W Groton Rd / County Hwy-100. Turn Right to stay on W Groton Rd / County Hwy-100. After about ½ mi. make a slight Right onto Smith Rd. / County Hwy-178. Site is on the Right.

## Paws for Thought Farm

### Potty Fee

Effective March 1, 2018, Paws for Thought Farm (PFTF) will be implementing a Potty Fee for any and all Potty Accidents (poops or pees) on the turf. The Potty Fee will be one amount if the Potty Accident is reported to us at the time of the Potty Accident and a different amount if the Potty Accident is discovered by PFTF. In the spirit of full disclosure, for those of you who don't know we have video cameras installed in the building which record video when there is activity in the Building. These cameras were originally installed for security purposes; however, it looks like they will now be used for monitoring purposes.

The details of the Potty Fee are as follows:

- First Potty Accident
  - if reported - \$5.00
  - if unreported and discovered - \$10.00
- Second Accident within 3 months
  - if reported - \$10.00
  - if unreported and discovered - \$20.00
- Third Accident within 6 months
  - if reported - \$20.00
  - if unreported and discovered - \$40.00
