****NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS ****

Tarps (waterproof) must be used under all crating. NO food or drinks except water is allowed on the sprint turf.

Crate-aggressive dogs are not to be situated near any of the rings or busy walkways. This includes outside in vehicles.

- **OPENING DATE 8:00 a.m. Aug 13, 2021** at 250 Trail Rd., Hershey, PA 17033. **CLOSING DATE** for entries 6pm, **Sept 24, 2021** after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules and in Chapter 1, Section 20 of the AKC Agility Trial Rules and Regulations.
- **ENTRY FEE** \$25.00 for the first entry of a dog; \$15.00 for each additional entry of the same dog per day. *(Includes a \$3.50 AKC recording fee for the first run and \$3.00 each additional.) Envelopes/transactions cannot have entries for more than the (10) dogs maximum.*

JUNIOR HANDLER FEE: \$15- 1ST RUN, \$13 EA. ADDL RUN

- **Entries not submitted on the current official AKC Entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules attached to the Official AKC Entry Form or correct funds are not acceptable. Exhibitors are responsible for errors in making out entry forms.**
 - **Declination of Entries:** The Williamsport Dog Training Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove dogs on account of disease, viciousness or other causes and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the WDTC or any official thereof.
 - **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the event committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The WDTC / Sportzone & Scores-N-More and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
 - **REFUND POLICY: No entry fee** will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee.
- Bitches in season** are not permitted to compete in agility trials. A Service Fee of \$10 / dog / day for bitches in season or injured dogs will be granted when a veterinarian's letter is presented as proof to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the 1st trial day dog is entered. Must use official Veterinary's Letter Head.
- This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. This includes the areas surrounding the outside of the showbuilding.
 - Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. Williamsport Dog Training Club will add a \$45 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.
 - **JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS.** The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.
 - Dogs participating must be fifteen months of age or older and must be registered with the American Kennel Club or have an AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/LP), or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Dogs must be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. All height divisions will be offered in both the standard classes and the jumpers with weaves classes.

Regular exhibitors may choose to enter their dog in a higher height division than required by AKC, but not in a height division lower than the AKC mandated height.

Preferred exhibitors are required to jump in their proper height division.
