FROM Ithaca via NY 34B: Left onto Sharpsteen Rd, Right onto County Hwy-153 / Pleasant Valley Rd., Take 1st left onto Smith Rd / County Hwy-178. Site is on the Left.

FROM Syracuse via I-81 S: I-81 S to **EXIT 12** for US-11 / NY-41 / NY-281 toward "Homer/Cortland". Merge onto Main Street Connector. Left onto SR 281 / NY 281 about 2.2 miles. Right onto SR 222 / NY 222 and follow about 9.2 mi. Left onto Main St / NY38. Take 1st Right onto Spring St / County Hwy-100. Stay straight to go onto Spring Street Ext. / County Hwy 190. Take 1st Left onto Smith Rd / County Hwy – 178. Site is on the Right.

FROM Binghamton via I-81 N: Take Exit 11 for NY-13 toward Cortland. Left onto NY13 / Clinton Ave. Right onto Clinton Ave / NY-13. Stay straight to go onto Groton Ave / NY-222. Follow NY-222 about 10.4 mi. Left onto Main St / NY-38 then 1st right onto Spring St / County Hwy-100. Stay straight to go onto Spring Street Ext. / County Hwy 190. Take 1st Left onto Smith Rd / County Hwy – 178. Site is on the Right.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies. I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lesser of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless for any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred Classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete, however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

TRIAL REGULATIONS -- NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. All height divisions will be offered in both the standard classes and the jumpers with weaves classes. Dogs in the Preferred classes must jump their measured height since they are not allowed to jump in a higher height as dogs in the regular classes are. If you are unsure of your height or your dog is borderline and you don't have a height card please enter the lower height and if necessary the judge will move you up.

OBSTACLES: All obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the *AKC Regulations for Agility Trials*.

ENTRY FEE: **\$24.00** for the first entry per dog per day and **\$14.00** for each additional entry of the same dog per day. Fees include AKC recording fee of \$3.50 per entry.

MOVE-UPS: Per American Kennel Club Regulations for Agility Trials, dogs may be moved up to a higher class, at the request of the Owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title.

Before the trial, email move ups prior to the move-up deadline via to scoresnmore@comcast.net or USPS in writing to Bonnie Reifsnnyder, 250 Trail Rd., Hershey, PA 17033. Verbal / Text move ups will not be accepted.

Move ups are due in writing to the Trial Sec. by **Monday, 8 /18 / 2025 at 6:00 pm.**

Day-to-Day Move-ups WILL BE ACCEPTED. The request for the move up must be made in writing at the trial site to the Trial Secretary not later than the day preceding the event. After each trial ends, requests must be submitted in writing within 15 minutes after the last run of the trial day for the following day(s) and cannot be conveyed via fax, email, phone or verbally. Forms will be available at the site close to the Results Posting area.

REFUNDS: . After the close of entries, partial refund requests for bitches in season or injured dogs or handlers will be accepted. Those requests must include a veterinarian's or doctor's note and must be received by the trial secretary before the first run on the first day the dog is entered in the trial. Refund requests will be on a case-by-case basis and will be at the discretion of the trial committee. Refunds after the close of entries will be minus a club service fee of **\$6.00 / dog / day for Bitches in Season.** Partial refunds for an injured dog / handlers will be charged a service fee of **\$13.00 / dog / day.**

ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT WHEN IN THE RING OR IN THE DESIGNATED WARM-UP AREA.

Trial Secretary will not be held responsible for entries or changes not received at all or not received by any deadline. It is the **exhibitor's responsibility to follow up on any correspondence with the Trial Secretary before any deadline date.** If you do not get an email reply back from the Trial Secretary it most likely means she did not get it and you need to try to contact again using an alternative form of communication.

THE SAFETY of dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.

TELEPHONE, FAX, EMAIL OR UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted.

NO HAND-DELIVERED ENTRIES will be accepted within the first 24 hours.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules attached to the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE. ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES** will not be accepted.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE. Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without the recipient's signature.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, extreme weather, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS-Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed. No changes to errors made by the exhibitor on trial day. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to read the confirmation letters and correspond with the Trial Secretary to make any needed changes before the trial or any deadlines. No exceptions.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

DOGS PRESENT will not be permitted to roam. Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crate at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. The site will be monitored, and offenders will be asked to leave. In such cases, no refunds will be made. Dogs must use the designated exercise area.

EVENT COMMITTEE will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

BITCHES IN SEASON shall not be eligible to participate. See **"REFUNDS"** for complete refund policy.

DOGS PARTICIPATING must be 15 months of age or older and must be registered with the American Kennel Club, have an AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privilege (PAL/ILP), AKC Canine Partners Listing, or be approved FSS breeds eligible to compete. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. All American dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided the listing number has been recorded on the entry form and the trial is open to All American dogs.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRY ACCEPTANCE will be emailed as the entries are processed for those exhibitors that provide an email address. Also, a Final Confirmation email, including the judging schedule, will be sent to all exhibitors after the closing date.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO):

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered at any level (Novice, Open Excellent or Masters) in FAST, JWW, Standard or Premier classes. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.
- Course time for FEO in Time 2 Beat, JWW, Standard, Premier and ISC will be 45 seconds. FAST courses times for each class/height are as noted in the Regulations.

Reminder for Mixed Class entries:

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

FEO and Fix and Go On have been approved by the AKC Board of Directors to remain a permanent part of the AKC Agility program.

Fix and Go On (FNG):

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.
