#### NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

**ENTRY FEE**: \$30.00 (includes \$4.50 AKC Recording Fee) for the first entry of a dog and \$25.00 for each additional entry of the same dog, same trial. Rally is not used as a second entry in combination with Obedience. There are two rally trials on Saturday, discounted entries can only apply to the same trial of the first entry.

OPEN DATE: ENTRIES OPEN: For Shetland Sheepdogs ONLY, entries open February 18, 2026, at 8 AM. Entries open February 25, 2026, at 8 AM for all AKC recognized breeds & All American dogs CLOSING DATE for entries at 6 PM on April 8, 2026. A wait list will be started if the numerical limit has been reached before 12 Noon, April 8, 2026 (at Trial Secretary office) after which entries cannot be accepted, canceled, or substituted, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules. A Wait List to be established if limits are reached before closing date. AKC RECORDING FEE OF 50¢ & an AKC Event Service Fee of \$4.00 is required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. If a dog is entered in more than one class in one of these events, the AKC Recording Fee and Service Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2). An AKC Recording Fee of \$4.50 will be required for each entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. If a dog is entered in more than one class in a Rally event, the AKC Recording Fee is to be collected on each of the entries of that dog. (AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 3). All Recording Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

**RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. SNM will add a \$35.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

**ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES** will not be accepted. Telegraph and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are not acceptable.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if a dog has been processed, no refund will be made.

**Refund and Cash award checks** are void after 180 days and will NOT be re-issued.

**ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS.** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Trial Secretary will make every effort to decipher illegible handwriting but is not responsible for errors due to illegible writing.

**ENTRY FEES** shall not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made after closing date.

**BITCHES IN SEASON**. Since bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials, 50% of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason will be refunded. To be eligible for such refund, the Trial Secretary must be notified in writing ½ hour or earlier prior to start of first class of the trial together with a veterinarian's certificate on their letterhead confirming the fact that the bitch is in season.

CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING. All dogs should arrive 15 minutes before judging time. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Dogs will be judged in catalog order. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when requested.

THE SHOW COMMITTEE will use care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability, in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in the show.

THE OBEDIENCE TRIAL AND RALLY TRIAL will be open from 7:30 A.M. to ½ hour after trial ends. DECLINATION OF ENTRIES/REMOVAL OF DOG: The trial committee may refuse to admit or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the trial-giving club or any official thereof. All dogs must be on leash or confined to a crate except when being judged.

# IMPORTANT EXHIBITOR INFORMATION – PLEASE READ

- READ "NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS" AND "AGREEMENT PAGE" ON ENTRY FORM. When either physically signing or e-signing your entry, you are confirming you have read, understand, and agree to the agreement.
- All judging will be indoors. This is a one-ring trial.
- Bring your own chairs. Protective padding is required under all chairs and wire crates. No high-heeled shoes.
- Crating space is limited. Unentered dogs may be asked to leave.
- No ex-pens. No dogs under 4 months of age on show grounds
- No dog belonging wholly or in part to a judge, or superintendent, or any member of such
  a person's household may be entered in any obedience trial at which such person
  officiates or is scheduled to officiate. Nor may they handle or act as agent for any dog.
- Write legibly! Include A or B class and jump height if required.
- <u>CHECK ALL YOUR INFORMATION</u> WHEN YOU RECEIVE YOUR ENTRY CONFIRMATION. It is much easier to correct a mistake immediately rather than to wait a week before the trial when everything is printed and ready to go.
- There will be no smoking in the building or on the grounds. Please dispose of trash in the proper manner
- Clean up after your dog. Anyone observed not doing so will be asked to leave the trial immediately. There will be no refund.
- Free admission/free parking. PARKING IS TO BE ON BLACKTOP ONLY
- Judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called.
- All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The host club or Trial Secretary will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- "Dog" refers to either sex.
