	ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERNATIONAL SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES (ISC): Purpose: The International Sweepstakes Class (ISC) is a non-regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various International Style Standard and Jumpers with Weaves courses. The rules for this class are generally based on international rules. The variety in International Agility course designs is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the "Challenge of the Day" when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult, or simply different from what is currently allowed in Excellent / Master Class. Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC Website (http://www.akc.org). Eligibility: ISC classes are open to dogs that are eligible to compete in AKC agility trials. There is no Preferred Option for ISC; dogs may enter at their preferred jump height, however they will be scored against the regular division dogs jumping the same jump height. Jump Heights: Dogs may be entered in their regular jump heights, however, only those dogs running in the 12", 16", 20" and 24" class that meet the FCI/ISC measuring cutoff (different than regular AKC cutoffs) may use their clean run toward the required qualification toward entering WTT or EOTT. Please see the 2026 EO/AWC Tryout Rules for further details. The FCI/ISC cutoffs for those heights are as follows: ➤ Small (12" jump height) – for dogs measuring 13 ¾" or less at the withers ➤ Medium (16" jump height) – for dogs measuring more than 13 ¾" and up to 16 7/8" at the withers ➤ Intermediate (20" jump height) – for dogs measuring more than 16 7/8 but less than 18 7/8" at the withers. ➤ Large (24" jump height) – for dogs measuring over 16 7/8" at the withers ISC level description: A1 (Agility 1) and J1 (Jumping 1) are the beginning levels of FCI/ISC Courses.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners/agents are responsible for entering into the proper height divisions. All height divisions will be offered in both the standard classes and the jumpers with weaves classes.

Regular-class exhibitors may choose to enter their dog in a higher height division than required by AKC, but not in a height division lower than the AKC mandated height. **Preferred** exhibitors are required to jump in their proper height division.

Handlers may opt to run their dog in a higher height division.	Handlers must run their dog in their proper eligible height.	Owners are responsible for entering their dog in the proper height division.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training the dog.

OBSTACLES AND RINGCONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Tarps are to be used under all crates.

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such a case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. DVGSDC, Scores-N-More & Orchard Hills Training Center and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. DVGSDC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the DVGSDC or any official thereof. All dogs must be on leash always attached to their handler when on trial grounds except when in designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the trial committee at this trial will be strictly enforced, including, and not limited to the recorded information of this premium list. Puppies under 4 months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials.

ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number (in trials offering mixed breed entries), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number (in trials allowing mixed breed entries) must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

REFUNDS

No entry will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the action of the event committee.

Refunds for injured dogs/ injured handlers: A refund of entries minus a DVGSDC service fee of \$10.00 / dog/ day for injured dogs will be granted when a veterinarian's letter is presented as proof to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the 1st trial day dog is entered. Must use official Veterinary's Letter Head. Official Doctor's Letter Head must be used in the case of an injured handler.

Leashes

All dogs must be on leash at the trial. Retractable leashes are not allowed in the building. Dogs may only be off leash while running the course or at the practice jump.

Directions from Allentown, Harrisburg, Central New Jersey:

78 east or west to Allentown exit, Cedar Crest Blvd. South to Emmaus past hospital, at "T" turn right (Chestnut Street or Rt. 29 S) continue south on Rt.29 to Rt.100 South, continue to Hereford - 4 more miles to Bally. Middle of town is Longacre Electric (orange and blue sign) turn onto N.Church Street, go up hill approx. 1 mile. See pond on left side, turn left onto Bella Vista Lane. Continue on gravel drive until you see the buildings

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in all classes.

Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.

- Dogs may be entered at any level (Novice, Open Excellent or Masters) in FAST, JWW, Standard or Premier classes. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.

- Course time for FEO in Time 2 Beat, JWW, Standard, Premier and ISC will be 45 seconds. FAST courses times for each class/height are as noted in the Regulations.

“Anyone in violation of a restriction pursuant to AKC rules or policies, or the law can be asked to leave the grounds. If the person fails to leave, the local authorities will be contacted. In addition, if the club believes laws, restrictions, or conditions of release are being violated by an individual’s attendance or participation in AKC events, the local authorities will be contacted immediately as they have the authority of enforcement.”

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division. All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running. Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
