OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ERRORS in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

REFUNDS: Will NOT be issued in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

Entry will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, a public emergency, an act of public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season: A refund **will be** issued minus a \$5/ day processing fee. Notification must be made to the Secretary by 12 noon on the day of the trial with a veterinary certificate.

CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM Dogs will not be permitted in the building until just prior to their class being judged. Please refer to detailed instructions which will be sent in the Entry Confirmation document. Dogs not required for further judging are excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The trial-giving club and the Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system, stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs not brought into the ring when required.

All classes will be judged from tall to small each day.

DOGS MUST BE HELD ON LEASH or confined to crates except when being judged.

EXHIBITORS MUST CLEAN UP AFTER THEIR DOGS at show sites and motels.

THE TRIAL COMMITTEE/SECRETARY will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, nor assume liability in the event of any accident or misfortune to dogs or exhibitors participating in this trial.

THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for this event.

EXHIBITORS SHOULD FOLLOW THEIR VETERINARIANS' RECOMMENDATIONS to assure that their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. New York State law requires that dogs aged four months and older be vaccinated against rabies.

MOVE-UPS to a higher class are permitted as provided for in Chapter 1, Section 16 of the Obedience/Rally Regulations.

RALLY JUMP HEIGHTS (Advanced, Excellent, Masters): Height at withers under 10 inches: jump height 4 inches. Height at withers 10 inches to under 15 inches: jump height is 8 inches. Height at withers 15 inches to under 20 inches: jump height 12 inches. Height at withers 20 inches and over: jump height 16 inches. **Rally Ring** will be 40'x50 '

ALL Obedience and Rally Classes will be judged by jump height. Make sure your dog's jump height is on the entry.

All days will be judged from tall to small. Judging will be indoors.
